What's happening in Term 6...

Christchurch preschool reopened our doors on Monday 8th June to key worker children and school leavers. This was after writing risk assessments, planning the room to minimise risk and seeing what resources could be available and cleaned easily, and purchasing PPE. We divided the room in half and the children into two bubble groups with separate toilets and staff in each group. The children have come in independently, we have allowed the children to slowly settle back in and they have adapted so well to the changes in the room. They follow the hand washing rules and don't mix their bubble groups. Staff are following vigilant cleaning routines each session.
